



What: Trail Design Specialists TRAIL MASTER CLASS

Overview

This course will cover the latest advances in trail design, construction and maintenance with a focus on long term sustainability and ease of maintenance. The last day will be field application on the concepts we covered on the previous days interspersed with leadership techniques for working with volunteers.

Trail Design and Layout

We will cover advances on how to properly design and layout a trail. We will discuss how to avoid erosion, user conflicts, and impact problems through design. This session will give you a good working knowledge of what causes trails to erode through water/soil relationships. An outdoor session will consist of a series of flagging and layout drills designed to utilize the concepts covered in the classroom.

Students are to pack their lunches each day. Leatherwood Mountains will provide camp sites (please call to reserve) from Tuesday to Sunday. If you need a stall, please call to reserve as well. Stalls are \$20 per night/per horse. There will be a cookout provided by TDS on Saturday evening in the campground.
